Recently we put a UV light sterilizer on our heating system. I have noticed that we are having fewer kids and staff getting sick.

We are switching over to LED lights in different areas as lighting fixtures fail. This will reduce our power costs and these bulbs are not glass and safer for our kids.

We just replaced all of our smoke detectors with ones that have sealed in lithium batteries that work for 10 years. No more wondering if the smoke detector has a missing or dead battery.
